GLASS / FOOD / JEWELRY

GLASS—Jackie Lewis fell in love with stained glass when a Safeway client in California showed her his work. This client taught her the copper foil method. Making use of the colors and patterns of the glass enhance the finished piece. Design varieties vary but finding the right glass to make an animal or bird look real is a challenging goal.

FOOD—When Mary Willy moved to Tucson, Jackie began making her Prickly Pear Jelly recipe. This item is available only if there is a good crop of Prickly Pear fruit. Depending on product availability, and Jackie's schedule, there may also be apple butter or apple sauce, pear butter and/or hot pepper jellies on the shelf. Late November and through December, guests can purchase homemade small batch English Toffee, nut brittle and fudge in a wide variety of flavors.

JEWELRY—Jackie needed something to help her wind down at the end of the day, and stringing beads has become a calming craft for her. She does not begin with a specific design in mind—the beads tell her where they want to be. She enjoys delicate pieces and usually incorporates something unexpected.
